# RULES & REGULATIONS of the Standard Chartered KL Marathon (SCKLM) 2009

- The Standard Chartered KL Marathon 2009 ("the Event") is organised by CMGRP (MALAYSIA) SDN BHD ("Octagon") & the Malaysia Amateur Athletic Union ("MAAU") collectively referred to as "The Organiser" in accordance with the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) rules and Standard Chartered KL Marathon (SCKLM) Rules & Regulations.
- By signing up for and providing any information, personal or otherwise, in order to gain access to any product(s) or service(s) and/or participate in any programme(s), event(s), talk(s), demonstration(s) or any activity(ies) involving the Organiser and the event sponsors ("the Sponsors"), the individual is deemed to have given written permission for the Organiser and the Sponsors to collect, analyse, collate, share, disclose to third parties, sell and/or otherwise use without any liability to the individual, any personal information relating to that individual as may in its sole discretion deem fit, including without any limitation for the following purposes:
  - For its programmes, planning, data-processing, and statistical or risk-analysis, research, fund-raising and/or any other purposes in furtherance of the functions, the Organiser and the Sponsors declare by virtue of being the Event owner or sponsor, they can use services of third parties;
  - For development or implementation of programmes, products or services as it may deem necessary;
  - For outsourcing of any programme(s), event(s), talk(s), demonstration(s) and/or any activities;
  - For promotional, marketing and/or administrative purposes;
  - For all purposes as required by law, including without limitation court proceedings, criminal investigations or prosecutions or where so ordered by any competent authority;
  - In connection with any proposed novation, assignment, transfer, sale, lease, license, partnership, joint-organizing and/or any collaboration where and when required in relation thereto.
- Completion of the official entry form, including online registration, confirms the participant's agreement to abide by the relevant rules and regulations of the Organiser, IAAF and the Sponsors.
- Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken by the Organiser to ensure the participants' safety, participants run at their own risk and the Organiser will not be responsible or held liable for any injury or death howsoever arising from training for or during participation in the race. Participants are strongly encouraged to go for a medical examination and/or consult their medical practitioner prior to registration and before the actual race day.
- The form on the reverse side of the participants' bib number must be completed in full and accurately. Participants must wear the assigned bib number on his/her chest. Participants who are not wearing a bib number will be taken off the course by security officers/ volunteers/ officials.
- Road closure will be lifted after six (6) hours from the commencement of the first race. Participants will then continue on the footpath at their own risk.
- A participant must retire from the race immediately, if required to do so by any member of the official medical staff, Race Director, Referee and/or Security Officer.
- Pets, bicycles, in-line skates, prams, push carts, shoes with built-in or attached rollers and any other wheel-run objects are not allowed on the course other than official race and medical vehicles.
- Once registration has been duly processed, there will be no fee refund for participants who do not eventually take part in the Event for whatever reason.
- There will be no fee refund if the event is cancelled for whatever reason.
- The Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of the Event, for any legitimate purpose including commercial advertising and distribution to the Sponsors.
- The Organiser reserves the right to limit and/or refuse entry
- The Organisers will not entertain nor be in any way responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete or inaccurate entry details in the registration form.
- Race category and race entry are strictly non-transferable.
- Participants who commence before the actual start time of his/her registered race will be disqualified. (Please refer to start time of each race)
- Participants must be 18 years and above on the race day to participate in the Full Marathon (42.195km).
- Participants must be 16 years and above on the race day to participate in the Half Marathon (21.1km) and 10km race.
- Participants must be 13 years and above on the race day to participate in the Fun Run (5km)
- Participants below the age of 18 are required to seek parental/guardian's consent and fill up the relevant indemnity declaration form as deemed necessary by the Organiser upon online registration or in-person registration failing which, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any participant.
- Races are categorised as follows:
  - Full Marathon (42.195km)
  - Half Marathon (21.1km)
  - 10km
  - 5km (Fun run)
  - Kids Dash (3km and 950m). This is a non-competitive event.
- The "GunTime" will be considered to determine the winners for each of the following categories:
  - Men's Full Marathon (Open Category)
  - Women's Full Marathon (Open Category)
  - Men's Full Marathon (Malaysian Category)
  - Women's Full Marathon (Malaysian Category)
  - Men's & Women's Half Marathon (Open Category)
  - 10km Men's & Women's (Open category)
 [Only Malaysia citizens qualify for (iii) and (iv)]
- Each participant is allowed to win only one prize-money award. A winning participant may elect to receive an award in another category to which he/she is entitled to that might offer a higher prize-money. Notwithstanding the participant's election, his/her finishing positions in each of the relevant categories do not change.
- For prize winners or possible prize winners, disputes and appeals must be made on-the-spot within 30 minutes of the published results on the results notice board on-site or immediately after the prize presentation, whichever is earlier failing which the Organiser reserves the right not to entertain any dispute or appeal thereafter.
- For all other participants, disputes and appeals regarding the results must be submitted in a written format including electronic mail within 7 days of the race day. The Organiser reserves the right not to entertain any dispute or appeal after 6 July 2009.
- All participants shall collect their race pack which consists of the bib number, DAG system (chip), Event singlet/vest, runner's guidebook and other novelties.
- All participants can return the bib with the timing system to the Recycle Bib Bin at the finish area after their race if they choose so completely on their own choice.
- All participants who successfully complete the race in the full marathon category will be awarded a finisher's medal.
- All finisher's medals are to be collected on race day. No requests thereafter will be entertained.
- All participants who successfully complete the race in their elected category will be awarded a finisher's certificate by mail. This will be sent in August 2009. The Organiser is not responsible for any undelivered certificate due to incorrect or incomplete address given or lost mail.
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse awarding a finisher's certificate to any participant if his/her race was not completed successfully.
- Corporate Challenge:**
  - Open to all companies registered in Malaysia. Participants must be employees of the same company. All decisions by the Organisers shall be final. Verification of eligibility must be provided upon request. The company with the shortest combined aggregate time completed by its staff wins the award.

- Sponsors of the Event are eligible for the award, including the plaque. They are however, not eligible for the prizes.
- In order to qualify for the Corporate Challenge, the companies, organisations and institutions have to sign up for the bulk registration package.
- Employees from the respective organisations that have registered individually will not have their clocked times factored into the Corporate Challenge for their organisation.
- Participants can only register and compete for one company/organisation under the Corporate Challenge.
- The companies, organisations and educational institutions have to provide a Company Coordinator to play the role of a liaison officer with the Organiser.
- The Company Coordinator is responsible for recruiting participants, finalising his/her company's race entries and obtaining and distributing race day materials to the participants.

- The Company Coordinator will be given an Administrative User ID and password for his/her company to access the registration system to key in the finalised participants' entries.
- No substitutions of participants will be allowed once the company, organisations or educational institutes entry has been submitted.
- Participants who register for the Corporate Challenge, under their organisation's bulk registration package are not entitled to any other discounts (SCB cardholder discount, etc) on top of the agreed bulk registration fees.
- Only the Company Coordinator can retrieve the timing of those participants registered under the bulk registration package. The Organiser has the right not to disclose any information on those company's staff that registered individually.
- Teams are entitled to win prizes only within the registered team category. The Organiser's decisions are final.

## 32. Kids Dash

The Kids Dash is being introduced for the first year and will feature 950-metre and 3km race designed for children aged 12 years old and below. Kids Dash provides children the opportunity to experience the thrill of running in a world-class marathon. Starting at the Dataran Merdeka, the kids will run along the Square, and finishing back at the Dataran Merdeka. This is a fun, non-competitive event that provides a memorable experience for families!

- Safety and having fun takes priority.
- Parents are responsible for the well-being of your children.
- If your children do not feel well on race day, please DO NOT allow them to participate in the run.
- Parents accompanying their children on the run are reminded to look out for other children when running.
- There will be one (1) start-off time for the Kids Dash by reference to age:
  - Between 6 – 9 years old\*
  - Between 10 – 12 years old\*
 \*Age as of on/before the race day.
- Participants must be 12 years and below on the race day to participate in the Kids Dash.
- Participants of Kids Dash shall be entered by their parent/guardian who will fill up the relevant indemnity declaration forms as deemed necessary by the Organiser upon online registration or in-person registration failing which, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any participant.
- For children aged 9 years old and below, only one parent/guardian issued with an identification tag, will be allowed to accompany the child.
- The Kids Dash is non-competitive, therefore, no timing device will be issued and no official timing will be recorded or provided.

- All Participants will be awarded a participation certificate.
- Please ensure your children report to the Start line half an hour before the flag off of their respective races.

## 33. Run For A Cause Participants

- Participants who register for the "Run For A Cause" programme in support of the Event's official charities in 2009, are bound by the specific rules and regulations of the "Run For A Cause" category. (More details can be found on [www.kl-marathon.com](http://www.kl-marathon.com)).
- The Organiser shall not be responsible or held liable for any illegal activities committed either by the official charity body, any organisations or participants who register and raise funds for the "Run For a Cause" category.
- All other charities or non-profit organisations have to seek the approval of the Organiser to take part in any fund-raising project using the Event as a platform but not in conjunction with the Event. Once approval is granted, they would have to inform the Organiser of their fund-raising activities through the Event, and the total amount raised from these activities within 1 month of Event date.

## 34. Race Pack Collection

- Runners are reminded to bring their Race Confirmation Slip, together with the Identity Card/ Photo ID, to collect the Race Pack. If you have misplaced the Race Confirmation Slip, you can go to the event website at [www.kl-marathon.com](http://www.kl-marathon.com) to print out your Race Confirmation Slip.
- If you are unable to collect your Race Pack, you may appoint your relatives, friends, or representatives in Malaysia to collect your Race Pack on your behalf with a Letter of Authorisation. Note that your relative, friend or representative in Malaysia is required to produce his/her Identity Card/ Photo ID, along with your Letter of Authorisation and photocopy of your NRIC/Photo ID upon request from the counter staff.
- Each appointed relative, friend or representative can collect up to a maximum of six (6) Race Packs including his own Race Pack if he is a registered runner.
- Please note that no changes in t-shirt sizes and race category will be entertained during the Race Pack collection.
- Entry packs not collected after the collection date will be deemed as property of the Organiser, who reserves the right to dispose or re-distribute them accordingly.
